



Crochet Pram Blanket



Crochet Pram Blanket (Intermediate)

MEASUREMENTS

Width (approx) 70 cms/28 ins
Length (approx) 90 cms/36 ins

YARN #097B 1 x 400g ball

HOOK

An 8.00mm (US L/11), (UK 0) Crochet Hook
or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

TENSION/GAUGE

10 sts and 7 rows to 10 cm/4 ins over treble fabric, using 8.00mm (US L/11), (UK 0) Crochet Hook.

Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for a successful item.

ABBREVIATIONS

Note - This pattern is written using Australian/UK terminology.

St/s - stitch/es, **RS** - right side, **WS** - wrong side,

ch - chain, **tr** - treble (US - double crochet), **dc** - double crochet (US - single crochet), **rep** - repeat, **sp** - space, **patt** - pattern, **cont** - continue, **beg** - begin/ning, **sl** - slip.

CREATE

Centre Panel

Using 8.00mm (US L/11), (UK 0) Hook, make 57ch.

1st row - 1dc in 7th ch from hook, 2ch, miss next ch, 1tr in next ch, * 2ch, miss next ch, 1dc in next ch, 2ch, miss next ch, 1dc in next st, rep from * to last 2ch, miss next ch, 1tr in last ch, **turn.**

2nd row - 1ch, 1dc in first st, * miss next 2ch sp, (1tr, 3ch 1tr) in next st, miss next 2ch sp, 1dc in next st, rep from * ending by placing last dc in 3rd ch of 7ch from previous row, **turn.**

3rd row - 5ch (counts as 1tr, 2ch), 1dc in next 3ch sp, 2ch, miss next st, 1tr in next st, * 2ch, 1dc in next 3ch sp, 1tr in next st, rep from * to end, **turn.**

4th row - 1ch, 1dc in first st, * miss next 2ch sp, (1tr, 3ch 1tr) in next st, miss next 2ch sp, 1dc in next st, rep from * ending by placing last dc in 3rd ch of 5ch from previous row, **turn.**

Last 2 rows (3rd and 4th rows) form patt.
Cont in patt until panel measures 70 cms/28 ins from beg, ending with a 3rd patt row.
Fasten off.

Edging

With RS facing, join yarn to any side edge of blanket, 1ch, work 72dc evenly along long edges of blanket, 3dc in each corner and 54dc evenly along short edges of blanket, join with a sl st to first st.

1st round - 4ch (counts as 1tr and 1ch), * miss 1 st, 1tr in next st, 1ch, rep from * to 3dc in corner, 1tr in next st, 1ch, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in next st, 1ch, 1tr in next st **, rep from * to ** until all corners are worked, then rep from * to end, joining with a sl st to 3rd of beg 4ch.

2nd round - 1ch, * 1dc in each st and 1ch sp to corner 2ch sp, (2dc, 2ch, 2dc) in corner sp, rep from * until all corners are worked, then work 1dc in each st and 1ch sp until end, join with a sl st to beg of round. Fasten off.

3rd round - With RS facing, join yarn to any 2ch corner sp, (3ch, 1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same sp, miss 3 sts, 2tr in next st, 2ch, 2tr in next st, miss 3 sts, [* (1tr, 4ch, 1tr) in next st, miss 3 sts, 2tr in next st, 2ch, 2tr in next st, miss 3 sts, rep from * to next corner sp, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner sp] 3 times, then rep from * to end, join with a sl st to 3rd of beg 3ch.

4th round - Sl st to 2ch corner sp, (3ch, 1tr, 2ch, 2tr) in same sp, 1tr in each of next 2 sts, miss 3 sts, 2tr in next st, 2ch, 2tr in next st, miss 3 sts, [* (1tr, 4ch, 1tr) in next st, miss 3 sts, 2tr in next st, 2ch, 2tr in next st, miss 3 sts, rep from * to 2 sts before next corner sp, 1tr in each of next 2 sts, (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) in corner sp] 3 times, then rep from * to end, join with a sl st to 3rd of beg 3ch.
Fasten off.

Trim

Using 8.00mm (US L/11), (UK 0) Hook, make a length of chain 280 cms/112 ins long.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Using yarn needle, darn in ends. Thread trim through 1st round of blanket edging, beginning and ending in centre of short side of blanket. Tie trim into a double bow.
